Do you have operational and instructional experience? Are you interested in delivering quality Emergency Management (EM) and Incident Management System (IMS) training across the province?

Level	Operational Experience	Instructional Experience
100	General knowledge (i.e., general knowledge and understanding of EM/IMS principles and concepts).	Emergency management, Incident Command System Canada (ICS Canada) or IMS teaching or training experience within the last three years. Understanding of adult education (e.g., workshops, courses, training, a certificate, or post-secondary education).
200	Managed, coordinated, or participated in one or more simple emergency and/or incident.	Level 100 requirements. Teaching experience within the last three years. Having co-taught a minimum of two level 200 courses.
250	Managed, coordinated, or participated in one or more simple incident in an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).	Level 100 requirements. Teaching experience within the last three years. Having co-taught a minimum of two level 200 courses, including the IMS 250 course (IMS in EOCs).
300	Performed, managed, coordinated, or participated at a command level or general chief position (e.g., Incident Commander, EOC Commander, EOC Director, etc.) in a complex incident and for at least one operational period.	Level 200 requirements. Having taught a minimum of two level 200 courses as the lead instructor and having co-taught a minimum of two level 300 courses.

Note: Instructors will only be endorsed for courses that they have participated in, and passed, as a student.
